The Honourable Marcia Neave AO was a Judge of the Victorian Supreme Court of Appeal from 2006, until her appointment as the Chair of the Royal Commission into Family Violence in 2015.

She has been a professor at three Australian universities and has always had an interest in the way the law responds to the needs of women.

The Honourable Justice Rita Zammit began her career as a secondary school teacher before studying law and commencing a career in private practice. She is in charge of the Personal Injuries and Dust Diseases Lists in the Victorian Supreme Court. She was appointed as an Associate Judge in 2010 and a Judge of the Supreme Court in February 2015.

She has extensive legal experience specialising in health law, insurance law and personal injuries litigation.
