Antoinette is an Aboriginal woman who was born on Wurundjeri country. Her grandfather and mother's line is through the Kuku Yalanji.

Antoinette is the CEO of Djirra, a position she has held since the service was established in 2002.

Antoinette as CEO is an active member of major key statewide committees in Victoria including Victorian Aboriginal Justice Forum and Dhelk Dja Forum.

Antoinette seeks to give voice and visibility to Aboriginal and Torres Strait Islander people who experience family violence. She is a strong advocate for Aboriginal and Torres Strait Islander community control, and self-determination.

Djirra is the Woiwurrung word for the reed used by Wurundjeri women for basket weaving.

Traditionally, when women gathered to weave, important talks took place and problems were solved. Djirra symbolises Aboriginal women today, still coming together to share stories, support each other and find solutions.
