In April 2026, the Monash University Faculty of Law launched the Warren Centre for Civil Justice named in honour of Monash alumna and VWL Patron Professor the Honourable Marilyn Warren AC KC — the first woman, and 11th person, to serve as Justice of the Supreme Court of Victoria, from 2003 to 2017.

Formerly the Australian Centre for Justice Innovation (ACJI), the renamed Centre represents Her Honour's contribution in shaping the legal profession and civil justice system to date — and a symbol of how she continues to do so through her legal research with Monash and Associate Professor Genevieve Grant.
